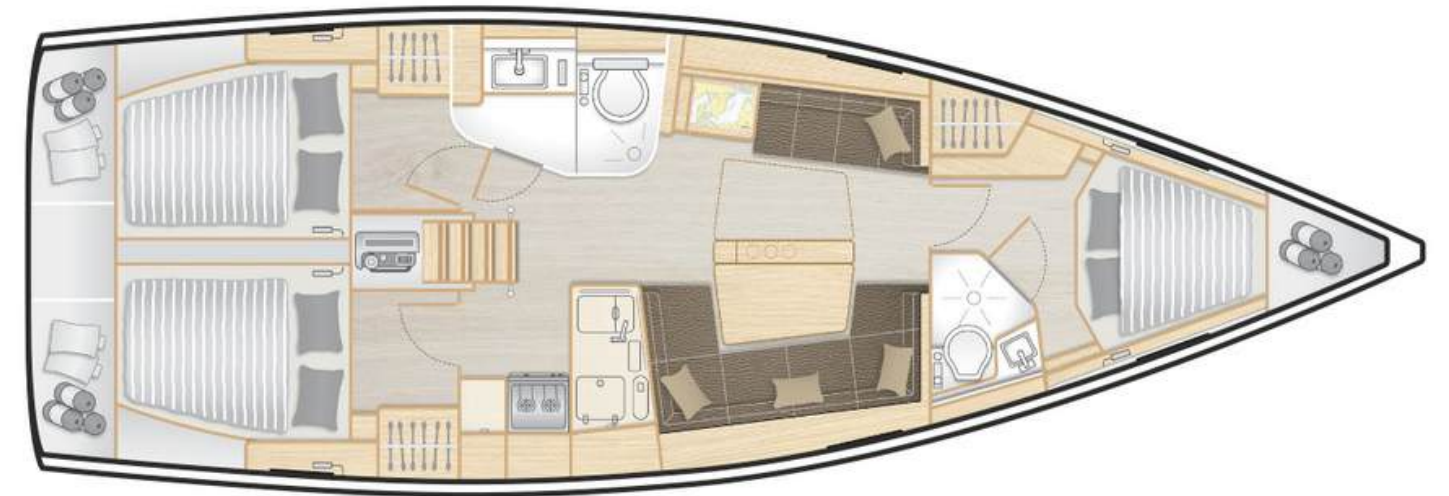

Accommodation:

- Pillows, bed linen, towels (2 per person)

Cockpit and Exterior:

- Equipped with a cockpit refrigerator, cushions, shower, and table
- Twin steering wheels and teak cockpit for a premium experience
- Electric windlass and pilot station for smooth operation

Deck Equipment:

- Dinghy (Plastimo Inflatable, 2.1 m) for 2–3 people

- 20kg Ultra anchor with a 60m chain

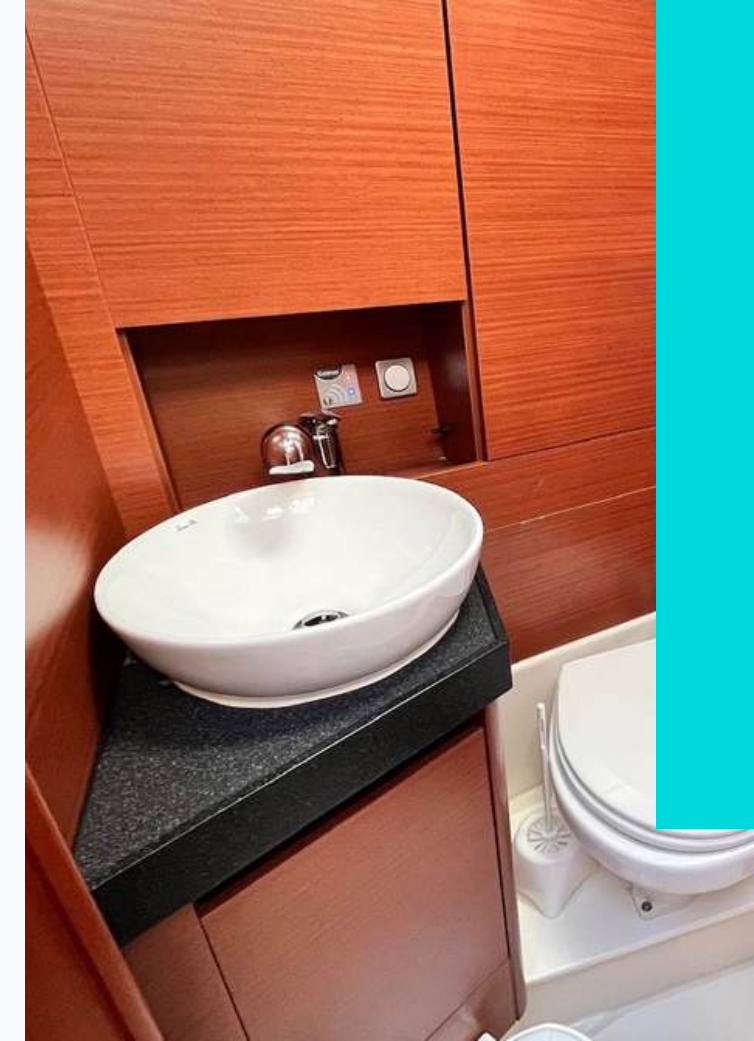
